Lean-to Reservation Form

Two lean-tos or open camps are available to SUNY Cortland alumni, faculty/staff, guests, and students by reservation through the William H. Parks Family Center for Environmental and Outdoor Education.

The lean-to closest to the water is named Beach and the one on the hill named Wood. The lean-tos are accessible by water only and are approximately a two mile paddle from Antlers. Canoes may be rented from Antlers for \$15 per day with prior notice. There are times when no canoes will be available. The SUNY Cortland staff reserve the right to prohibit launch in cases of inclement weather, fog, or darkness. There are no provisions for motorized boats at Camp Marion.

Reservations must be made a minimum of one week prior to intended stay. Reservation may be obtained by email, outdoor.edinfo@cortland.edu, or phone, 607-753-5488. Those camping without a reservation will be asked to leave. Cancellations should be called in as soon as possible.

You must be a SUNY Cortland affiliated person to reserve a lean-to. No person under 18 years of age can reserve the lean-to. The person making the reservation is responsible for the conduct of all persons in the party and is liable for any violations of rules and regulations committed.
