As faculty, staff, or CAS employees of SUNY Cortland, you have a unique opportunity to enjoy a memorable experience each summer in the heart of the Adirondack Mountains. Join us at the William H. Parks Family Center for Environmental and Outdoor Education at Antlers for a five/four day stay. Activities and equipment available at the center include canoeing, kayaking, biking and paddle boarding. Hiking trails and local shopping is all around us, as well as great fishing. Yard games, youth nature backpacks and beach toys are also available in/near the main office.

LODGING: Guests will be assigned to housing according to family size and needs. Showers and bathrooms are located in most rooms. Bed linens and towels must be provided by all participants. Bring your pillow and a light sleeping bag or sheets and blankets. All guests are required to keep rooms in a neat and orderly condition and to leave them in “as good, or better” condition, as there are no janitorial services available. Cleaning supplies and equipment are provided. Arrival time is 2-4 p.m. on your arrival date, with an all camp orientation at 5 p.m., and dinner at 6 p.m. Guests will depart after breakfast on the last day of your session.

MEALS: All meals will be served in the Cummings Dining Hall. Breakfast will be a buffet offered between 7:45-8:30 a.m. Lunch (12 noon) and dinner (6:00 pm) will be served family style. The first meal served for your stay will be dinner at 6 p.m. following the orientation. Every effort is made to provide tasty, nutritionally balanced meals. If you or someone in your party has special dietary needs please let us know as soon as possible.

PHONES: A single telephone is available at Antlers and is used for business and emergency purposes only. IN CASE OF EMERGENCY, the phone number is 315-354-4631. Cell phone service has improved somewhat over the years. AT&T and TRAC phones currently have the best service.

Families are responsible for the safety and well-being of their own children. There are no babysitters or lifeguards on site. Families should provide their own child sized life jackets. Due to the setting of Antlers, family pets are NOT permitted.

Registration can now be done online at sunycortland.formstack.com/forms/ant_alumni_camp Registrants will receive a Formstack confirmation stating the form was received. A \$50 deposit is required once a confirmation email has been sent from our office – Outdoor Education. The deposit will be applied to the total cost and will be non-refundable unless a three-week notice of cancellation is given. Reservations are on a first-come, first-served basis. You will be expected to pay any balance upon arrival either online (preferably) or with a check **payable to SUNY Cortland**. *Please note that we do not prorate the costs for partial stays.* Registration forms with rates are available on our webpage at www2.cortland.edu/rl-events A confirmation e-mail from Outdoor Education will be sent after receiving and processing the reservation form.
