## **Employer Survey Overview**

The Employer Survey is administered regularly with the last three iterations being in 2010, 2015, and 2017 to approximately 350 districts where our candidates are typically hosted and hired. Response rates for 2010 and 2015 were at 20% or more and 14% in 2017. Generally, employers have been satisfied with completers' preparation for their assigned responsibilities in working with P-12 students. The majority of employers across all three iterations of the survey agreed or strongly agreed that completers had strong content knowledge, pedagogical knowledge, instructional planning, respect for diversity, and the ability to create positive learning environments in their classrooms. In all three iterations over 60% of the respondents were from high needs districts and 69% or more had hired full-time employees that encompassed all of SUNY Cortland's education programs.
